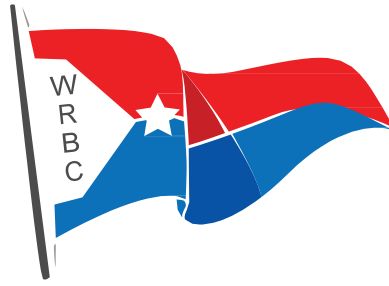

Excerpts from the WRBC Rules

- The White Rock Boat Club offers boat davits, racks and pads on an individual or family membership basis. The facilities are available to WRBC members, family and their guests only. All annual membership fees must be paid on or before April 1 of every year. Failure to pay dues for ninety (90) days results in immediate expulsion.
- Davits, racks and pads are offered to members on the basis of availability and suitability as may be determined by the WRBC Davit Registrar on a case-by-case basis.
- Individual members are responsible for the maintenance of the davit, rack or pad assigned to them as provided in the WRBC Bylaws.
- Two (2) mandatory “work days” are required of each club member for repair/maintenance of the pier and club facilities on days designated by the Board. A \$ 100.00 fine may be levied for each work day missed and failure to pay such fine may be grounds for being deemed “inactive” by the Board and expulsion.
- No member may work on any part of the WRBC facilities without having major medical insurance coverage. Membership of non-sailboat owners is limited by the Bylaws to 30% of the total membership. The approval of your application may be delayed if you are not a sailboat owner and/or that percentage has been reached.
- Boater Education Certification and sailing lessons may be provided by WRBC to members and non-members from time to time. The WRBC is not responsible for any injury to persons or damage to property caused by, or which may result from, providing or taking sailing lessons.
- WRBC facilities may be reserved for use by club members and their guests for social occasions free of charge by contacting the Commodore in writing 48 hours prior to the event for permission. See the website for additional details.
- The WRBC Commodore must approve of every boat as being appropriate in weight, length and seaworthiness prior to it being placed in any WRBC davit, rack or pad.
- A member deemed “inactive” by the WRBC Board becomes subject to expulsion and loses all membership privileges. WRBC is not responsible for bodily injury to, or for loss of or damage to property of members, visitors or guests.

White Rock Boat Club Shared Boat – Sailaway Program



White Rock Boat Club Shared Boat Program (Sailaway)

White Rock Boat Club offers members the opportunity to join our Sailaway Program. Members of the Sailaway Program pay a fee in addition to their regular dues. They then have use of the five boats currently owned by the Sailaway Program. Presently this fleet has three Flying Scots and two Harpoons. All five boats are ready to sail with sails (jib and main) and personal flotation devices. They are checked out through the Sailaway Program website maintained for program members.

In order to join the Sailaway program you must:

- Be a member of the White Rock Boat Club, or apply to join the WRBC concurrently with applying to join the Sailaway program.
- Pay the required annual Sailaway fee, \$300, in addition to membership dues.
- Pass the free State Boat Safety exam available at <http://www.boatus.org/onlinecourse/Texas.asp>.
- Be checked out by an approved Sailaway instructor to insure that you have the necessary boat handling skills to safely manage the boat from departure to return.
